

I. TECHIMPACT ACADEMY

Inspiring university students to create impact through technology

The TechImpact Academy program aims to empower students with the knowledge and experience to create meaningful change and social impact through technology. By working on projects that utilize technology to address pressing social or environmental challenges, participants gain invaluable skills in both technology and leadership.

Our program can be offered online, offline, or in a hybrid format. Through a series of interactive sessions under the guidance of experienced mentors, student teams will follow the design thinking process to investigate the problem, ideate solutions, create a business model, develop prototypes, and test their idea.


Anaphero - Ireland

II. TECHIMPACT INCUBATOR

Empowering early stage entrepreneurs to launch

Our Incubator Program aims to help early stage and youth entrepreneurs go from zero to one. We select committed early stage entrepreneurs (regardless of prior experience) and guide them to a process of refining their idea, creating a working prototype (MVP), developing a business model and financial plan, and getting to market.

The cohort of entrepreneurs get access to online hands-on workshops as well as dedicated mentorship from leading tech, business, and social impact mentors.

We can customize our incubator based on thematic elements, SDG themes, or regional focus based on the needs of the clients. Examples include Women in STEM, AI for Good in emerging economies, social entrepreneurship, and more.

To enrich the learning experience, we can also offer an offline immersive Accelerator Camp with rigorous tech and innovation workshops, skill-building seminars, hands-on projects, site visits to tech start-ups, cultural tours along with mentorship from successful entrepreneurs and tech experts.

In 2022, PIM successfully incubated an Algerian agritech startup named FarmAI that focused on using modern technologies to revolutionize farm yields. With the support of PIM, this startup went on to win second place in the Seeds for the Future Global Competition.

A year later, they received a project investment of 100,000 USD from Huawei to implement their business plan and the founders were also personally congratulated by the President of Algeria.



IV. MODEL FOUNDATION

Empowering youths to support and evaluate effective local nonprofits

The Model Foundation is an experiential program that empowers university students to support and evaluate effective local nonprofits and social enterprises. Through the program, students build empathy and leadership skills, and gain a deeper understanding of how to tackle social and environmental challenges in their community.

Model Foundation equips and trains students with the skills to conduct high level research on local organizations focused on tackling social or environmental challenges. Students will select a local organization to research and will work on creating an evaluation of the organization's work and impact. Students will then present their findings to an investment committee and compete for a chance to win grant funding for the organization they've researched.


V. SUSTAINABILITY LEADERS INITIATIVE

VI. YOUNG INNOVATORS BOOTCAMP

Introducing middle and high school students to social entrepreneurship and innovation

The Young Innovators Bootcamp is an interactive summer program designed for 8-16 years old students. During this camp, students will undergo leadership, innovation, and entrepreneurship training while learning how to develop their own solutions to unique social and environmental challenges.

The Young Innovators Bootcamp is specially designed for middle to high school students and is focused on providing a hands-on, interactive experience in social entrepreneurship and innovation.

Topics that we covered in our training include ideation, customer identification, journey in empathy, bringing an idea to life, design thinking, and storytelling.

Impact Lab

Yenching Academy Of Peking University

Yenching Academy's Master's program in China studies emphasizes interdisciplinary approaches to contemporary Chinese society and culture. PIM's Impact Lab at Yenching connects scholars with non-profits and social enterprises, where they collaborate with local mentors to explore social impact and determine how to create the greatest change through funding and pro-bono support.

PIM's Zero to One Social Innovation Incubator provides undergraduate and graduate students with a "learning by doing" curriculum in social entrepreneurship. Student teams enroll in an online curriculum from Wharton School of Business, while building their own social enterprise with close mentorship, training from social entrepreneurs and real resources to implement their idea.

Action Fund

Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation

Goalkeepers, an initiative by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, unites global leaders to advance the UN's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). In 2019, PIM evaluated projects from Goalkeepers in China to promote SDG advocacy and empower youth to drive action. Selected projects received a total of 1 million RMB in funding.
